The freight must flow.






GLOSSARY



TRUCK – a large, heavy motor vehicle used for transporting goods and materials.



MILEAGE - a number of miles traveled.



TRAILERS – an unpowered vehicle towed by another (cannot stack).



CONTAINERS – an object that can be used to hold or transport something (can be stacked).



REEFERS – a refrigerated trailer that gets attached to a truck to transport perishables and other temperaturesensitive goods (like ice-cream or technology).

The Region of Peel in Ontario is recognized as a hub for transportation and trucking. Every day \$1.8 Billion in goods is moved to, through, and from Peel Region. Four in every nine jobs depend upon the movements of goods in Peel Region. Every day, approximately 68,000 vehicles transport goods over Peel Region roads.

Trucking and logistics keep the Canadian economy moving. The trucking sector plays a significant economic role in national and international supply chains. The industry represents 4.5 per cent of Canada's GDP, employs close to one million workers, and enables and supports the economic success of numerous key sectors – including forestry, construction, mining, agriculture, manufacturing, and more.
